Successful crisis management in the EU - what lessons can be drawn from the last three years?

But how can the sector be stabilised in the long run to prevent crises in future? What role should the intervention play in future, and where must dairy farmers take responsibility? The Executive Committee of the European Milk Board will be stating its position on this at Green Week in Berlin.
